# CERTIFICATE OF RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PARK POINT SNOWMOBILE CLBB, INCORPORATED

We, the undersigned, <u>Lloyd R. Vienneau</u> and <u>Elizabeth M. Erickson</u>, respectively the President and Secretary of the <u>Park Point Snowmobile Club, Inc.</u>, a corporation subject to the provisions of Chapter 317, Minnesota Statutes, known as the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby certify that the resolutions as hereinafter set forth were adopted by a two-thirds vote of the directors pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 317.27, Subd. 3,4 or by a unanimous written authorizations pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 317.27, Subd. 2, notice of such meeting, proposal to amend and nature of such proposal having been delivered to each member entitled to vote thereon at least five days prior to such meeting, held at <u>LaFayette Square</u>, in the City of Duluth, County of St. Louis, as designated in such notice, on the 19th day of June, 1980, by a unanimous vote of said members presented in person:

"Resolved that the following articles of incorporation of the <u>Park Point</u> Snowmobile Club, Inc., be restated to read as follows:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

# PARK POINT COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 317, Minnesota Statutes, known as the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby associate ourselves together as a body corporate and adopt the following Article of Incorporation: These Articles supersede and take the place of existing article and all amendments thereto:

#### ARTICLE 1.

The name of this Corporation shall be PARK POINT COMMUNITY CLUB, INCORPORATED.

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# ARTICLE II.

The purpose of this Corporation shall be to work for the betterment of the Park Point Community and the welfare of its residents.

# ARTICLE III.

This Corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its members.

# ARTICLE IV.

This period of duration of corporate existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

# ARTICLE V.

The location of the registered office of this corporation in this state shall be 3021 Minnesota Avenue, Duluth, Minnesota 55802.

#### ARTICLE VI.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The government of the Corporation and the management of its affairs shall be vested in a Board of five (5) directors. All directors shall be members of the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE VIII.

# ARTICLE IX.

The Corporation shall have no capital stock and the incorporators and members shall not be personally liable for the debts and obligations of the Corporation.

# ARTICLE X.

The Corporation shall have no corporate seal.

# ARTICLE XI.

The Board of Directors may from time to time, by vote of a majority of its members, make, alter, amend or rescind all or any part of the By-Laws of the Corporation, subject to the power of the members to change or repeal such By-Laws.

# ARTICLE XII.

Membership qualifications in this Corporation shall be established by the Board of Directors through the adoption of appropriate provisions in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

# ARTICLE XIII.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for civic or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are so organized and operated exclusively for such purpose."
